



## Flempton Golf Club

### Deputy Head Greenkeeper

Flempton Golf Club was founded in 1895 and the course was redesigned in 1906 by J.H. Taylor 5 times Open Champion. The resulting layout is a masterpiece of design, a 9-hole heathland fast running course with a unique clover leaf design. The club is located close to the historic market town of Bury St Edmunds, and sits adjacent to Lackford Lakes Nature reserve. The club has maintained its traditional ethos and is regarded as one of the best 9-holes golf courses in the UK.

Martin Ebert of Mackenzie & Ebert course architects has been engaged to provide a masterplan for course development in the years ahead. This blueprint pays homage to the original J.H. Taylor design whilst enhancing the golfing challenge for today's members, their guests and importantly the clubs future generations.

The club is now looking to recruit a Deputy Head Green-keeper. This is an exciting time to join the club and assist the Head Greenkeeper and management team in taking the Club to the next level through the roll-out of the Course Development Plan in the years ahead.
